Subject	GST Council decision on introduction of E-Way Bill mechanism nationwide

With the present e-way systems being managed at State level at the option of the States, traders and transporters are facing undue hardship in inter-state movement of goods due to non-uniform rules across the country. With such representations being made to the GST Council, 24th meeting of the GST Council held today to review the readiness of the hardware and software required for the introduction of nationwide e-way bill system. Firm decisions were taken by the GST Council to rationalise the issues being faced by the traders & transporters.

Gist of the decision taken by the GST Council:

GST Council decision heading	Gist of the decision taken by the GST Council
Implementation of e-way bill system on trial basis	The nationwide e-way bill system will be ready to be rolled out on a trial basis latest by 16th January, 2018
Usage of e-way bill system on voluntary basis	Trade and Transporter can start using this system on a voluntary basis from 16th January, 2018 onwards
Compulsory usage of e-way bill system for Inter-State movement of goods	The Rules for implementation of nationwide e-way bill for inter-state movement of goods will be notified with effect from 1st February 2018.
	These rules will be compulsory to be followed for inter-state movements of goods from the date of notification
Option with State Government for implementation of e-way bill system for Intra-State movement of goods	Both the inter-state and intra-state e-way bill generation will be ready to be implemented by 16th January 2018
	However, The States may choose their own timings for implementation of e-way bill for intra-state movements of goods on any date before 1st June 2018
E-way bill system being presently managed by few State Government may easily adopt to implement nationwide e-way bill system	States already having e-way bill system can be the early adaptors of nationwide e-way bill system even for Intra-State movement of goods

Note: Uniform system of e-way bill for inter-state as well as intra-state movement of goods will be implemented across the country by 1st June, 2018.
