GST Council in its meeting held on dated 10th March 2018, announced implementation of e-way bill system for intra-State movement of goods in a phased manner.

With E-way bills getting successfully generated which includes more than two crore e-way bills for intra-state movement of goods till 31st May 2018, it has been decided by the GST Council to implement E-Way Bill system for intra-state movement of goods in the following States:

Summary of State wise implementation of E-way system for intra state movement of goods, announced as on 31st May 2018 in addition to the above:

- ✚ With effect from 01st April 2018: Karnataka
- ✚ With effect from 15th April 2018: Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Kerala, Telangana and Uttar Pradesh.
- ✚ With effect from 20th April 2018: Bihar, Jharkhand, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Tripura & Uttarakhand.
- ✚ With effect from 25th April 2018: Arunachal Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Meghalaya, Sikkim and Puducherry
- ✚ With effect from 16th May 2018: Assam
- ✚ With effect from 20th May 2018: Rajasthan
- ✚ With effect from 25th May 2018: Maharashtra, Manipur, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Chandigarh, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu & Lakshadweep.

It has been mentioned in the press release note that e-way bill system for intra state movement of goods will be implemented throughout the country latest by 3rd June 2018. It has also been advised that Trade & Industry should get well versed with respect to the provisions of the e-Way Bill rules in order to avoid any difficulty. The provisions of Rule 138D of Central / State GST Rules, 2017 may be referred to for any grievance redressal.
